- Representation of Indigenous Persons and the Canadian Government are slowly dealing with their water situation.
- The need for money is not high on the list of priorities for the Indigenous People.

What is one of the most important needs, and where can our Franciscans be of service?

- The need for support, right relationship and being fraternity for all persons of our world is essential for the Indigenous People to be able to heal and come to terms with their Intergenerational trauma and sufferings.

We shared with our contact person about our ofs National JPIC Proposal and our desire to build relationships with the Indigenous People.
